Course Description: Objective of the program is to offer students the opportunity to become agents of change in international relations and diplomatic affairs. Benefits: This academic program enhances additional knowledge bandwidth and prepares students not only for careers in the foreign arena, intergovernmental organizations, international businesses but also in fields such as journalism, non-governmental organizations, not for profit foundations, foreign policy think tanks and academic research. The program combines problem solving, structural analysis, project development and management with a comprehensive theoretical and critical examination of the political, cultural, legal, and socioeconomic practices that make up our increasingly interdependent and complex world. The political and economic problems central to foreign relations today invariably transcend national boundaries, the international agenda encompasses technological, religious, ethno-linguistic, and humanitarian concerns, as well as the more traditional area of diplomatic activity. Drawing from multiple fields including finance, law, history, philosophy, and theology, this program is decidedly interdisciplinary.

- Programs contain subject based assignments and domain related optional webinars and workshops.
- The student gets an in-depth knowledge in the select academic discipline.
- The specialized knowledge and skills gained during the program equips students secure internships and various allied opportunities.
- During the course students get an optional opportunity to meet and interact with noted policy makers and practitioners in the field.

Program Delivery: The program shall be completed over the course of 6 Months and divided into 4 papers. Each Paper is compulsory and submission shall be in form of an online assignment. All papers shall have a predefined thematic area and subject specification which allow the students to track their learning progress throughout the duration of the program. The evaluation of the Candidates will be conducted through timely submission of assignments at the completion of each paper through email. There will be one final assignment post the completion of all four papers and on successful completion of the same the Diploma shall be awarded.

-For the sake of clarity, it must be mentioned that the mode of learning is Distance/Correspondence as has been wherein there would not be any regular classes by Course Mentors. The whole course structure is that you shall be dispatched study material digitally at the beginning of each Paper Cycle. The whole Course is divided into 4 papers each of varying duration. Each paper would be followed by a research cum application-based assignment. The evaluation is only in the form of these assignments.

-There would also be a final cumulative assignment in addition to the 4 paper specific assignments. Therefore, there would be 5 Assignments in total. There would then be a cumulative marking and award of the Diploma on successful completion.

-Information regarding thematic webinars organized by the institute, its partner institutions, other relevant authorities and organizations shall be sent to you regularly however they are an optional component of the program since many of the learners have their existing academic/professional commitments; attendance to them is optional.

-You always have access to your Course Mentors through a dedicated email address provided to you where you can send them all your academic queries and/or topical/thematic queries w.r.t. assignments or study materials or career guidance. They are always available to help and guide you in your learning journey.

-Candidates shall also be informed about regular national and international opportunities by our Placement Assistance Team (PAT) to support their academic study at IIGL. Post the completion of the program at the institute, candidates would remain an integral part of the IIGL community and our global alumni network and get priority access to all our events as well as encouraged to contribute actively in the programs and initiatives at national and international level.
